## FEBRUARY 10, 2015 BALLOT ISSUES: LEVY AND BOND

The Port Angeles School District Board of Directors has approved two ballot items for the February 10, 2015 special election: a two-year maintenance and operations levy and a bond to construct a new high school on the existing site to replace Port Angeles High School and renovate the Performing Arts Center.

Bond and levy monies serve two completely different purposes. A maintenance and operations levy helps pay the annual cost of running the District's schools – about 20.5% of the District budget. It funds school repairs, student transportation and supports extracurricular activities such as athletics and music programs.

Bond money is used to build or replace school buildings or major equipment. Bond elections occur much less frequently and have a longer duration. Dry Creek and Jefferson Elementary bonds will be paid off in December 2015, and the bond for a new high school will follow directly behind with the least impact on taxpayers.

The Levy: The estimated tax rate for the maintenance and operations levy is expected to be \$3.26 per \$1,000 of assessed property value, the same rate per \$1,000 as exists for 2015. The fixed amounts requested are \$8,637,144 in 2016 and \$8,723,516 in 2017.

The existing maintenance and operations levy, approved in February 2011, is set to expire December 31, 2015. The new levy would be a replacement levy, not a new tax. It would renew the current four-year levy which expires at the end of 2015 and would maintain levy funding for the School District for two years through 2017.

**The Bond:** A February 10, 2015 bond in the amount of \$98,254,000 for a term of 25 years will provide for the construction of a new high school on the existing site to replace Port Angeles High School and renovate the Performing Arts Center.

The estimated tax rate for the bond is expected to be \$2.06 per \$1,000 of assessed property value (a \$1.60 per \$1,000 increase over today's rates) for 25 years based on 2014 values.

A ballot for the School District February 10, 2015 levy election will be mailed to the homes of registered voters on or around January 21, 2015. Ballots must be returned by mail or in person to the Clallam County Courthouse by 8:00 p.m. February 10, 2015.
